This fantastic opportunity develops a range of skills using unique skills in an outdoor environment. Students will use this week to complete complete the expedition element of their bronze DofE accreditation and in turn complete the course!

IMPORTANT NOTE:

The DofE is onlu open to students in year 9. This is due to the age restrictions set out for the qualification.

Students must also be aware that if they would like to select the DofE offer, they will need to fully commit to attain the award. There will be a weekly compulsory club for DofE which will start shortly after half term. The week of the 10th-14th July will be the concluding component of the qualification where students will complete their expedition.

Continue rehearsals with a specific focus on acting skills and choreography!


FRIDAY
