A-level

You will be actively engaged in developing your photographic skills in a variety of processes over a two year course using; critical analysis skills, digital imagery, image manipulation, darkroom practices, and studio lighting.

You will expand on theory and practice, exploring and refining techniques further to meet the needs of your ideas.

You will build an effective and balanced portfolio of work that demonstrates technical skills, theory based knowledge and critical analysis. This portfolio may be used for interview at higher educational level, for securing external exhibitions or for entering industry at apprenticeship or employment level.
