The week concludes with an action-packed day at one of the UK's best theme parks: Thorpe Park!

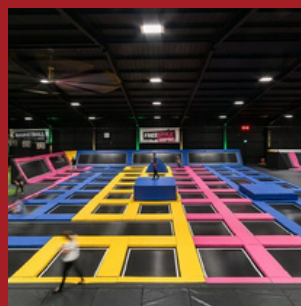

### MONDAY

Spend the day organising, setting up and participating in an obstacle challenge, featuring a range of inflatable courses!

### TUESDAY

Your nerves will be tested through range of challenges at Clip n' Climb and you'll need laser-sharp focus to complete a range of our sporting challenges.

### WEDNESDAY

You will be put through your paces at Basingbourn Barracks, where you will compete in a range of military-style obstacle courses!

### THURSDAY

You'll be rotating around 3 different epic activities that will put you through your paces. At Teamworks, you'll be go-karting, using racing simulators and battling it out in laser tag!

### FRIDAY

we will spend our final day on the water at Box End Park, where you will take part in paddleboarding and water-based assault courses.

For this day you must be able to swim 50m! If you cannot, you will not be able to take part in the water based activities.
